

# **Chouteau-Mazie Schools Child Find Notice**

The Chouteau-Mazie Public Schools are committed to an ongoing process of public awareness, location and screening of children ages 3 through 21 who may have disabilities. The School District has established and implements procedures and activities to ensure the evaluation and identification of children with disabilities who may be eligible for special education and related services.

Chouteau-Mazie Public Schools offer services to students who have Intellectual Disabilities, Deaf-Blindness, Other Health Impaired, Speech or Language Impaired, Traumatic Brain Injury, Visual Impairments, Autism, Multiple Disabilities, Orthopedic Impairment, Emotional Disturbance, Specific Learning Disabilities, and Deafness or Hearing Impairment. To locate these children, the School District uses posters, pamphlets and news releases to newspapers and radio stations to publicize the services available through the School District. The School District protects all personally identifiable information obtained through the search process as required by the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act and the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act.
